Directions to the Rodeo Grounds (Winter Show Building):

- From I-94 take exit 292 and turn north. Then turn right onto Winter Show Road (it's directly across from the Petro Serve gas station). As you drive east, the Winter Show Building will be on the south side of the road. There will be walk through gates for horses on the SW corner of the building. All trucks and trailers are able to circle to the west end of the stock pens, unload and keep moving.

Camping:

- The camper plugins are on a first-come first-serve basis. You can reserve a spot on the Stall/Camping form found on the website.

Stalls: Must be received by September 10th

- You must stall horses. No tying to your trailer.
- Check in at the stalling office is MANDATORY. If you stall in someone else's pen, there will be a padlock placed on your stall until you visit the office.
- There will be a stall sheet posted on the website.
- One bag of shavings will be provided for each stall. NO outside bedding allowed on the premises.
